- GREENGUARD Certified office furniture is a requirement reference in the Leadership for Energy and Environmental Design (LEED™) for Commercial Interiors Rating System (EQ Credit 4.5).

CONCEPT

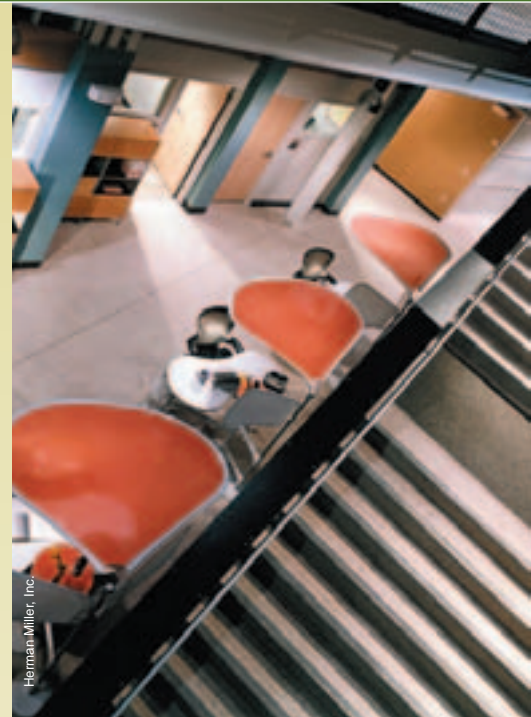
